TIP N°1

RELAX!

Questions are usually related to common topics.

- ✓ **Your hobbies**
- ✓ **Your work or education**
- ✓ **Things you like and things you don't like**
- ✓ **Friends and family**
- ✓ **Holidays**
- ✓ **Sports**
- ✓ **Future plans**

TIP N°2

HELP! I DIDN'T UNDERSTAND THE QUESTION!

Don't stress. Politely ask the examiner to repeat it.

- Please could you repeat that?
- Could you say that again, please?





TIP N°3

USE THE GRAMMAR OF THE QUESTION IN YOUR ANSWER

Here is a silly mistake!

A: Do you enjoy **cooking**?

B: Yes, I enjoy **to cook**.

This is a better option.

A: Are you **going to go** on holiday this year?

B: Yes! I am **going to go** to Mexico, It's **going to be** my first time.

Do you have to always use this method? No, but it will help you to avoid mistakes.



TIP N°4

USE KEYWORDS AND SYNONYMS

Using keywords inside the questions and synonyms related to the same topic help you to show off your English level.

A: What are your hobbies?

B1: I like gardening.

B2: I am keen on gardening.

A: What sort of holidays do you like?

B: My holidays are usually at home or nearby my city. I'm actually not too keen on travelling, and I really hate flights but I do like cruises. That is my favorite about all.





TIP N°5

JUSTIFY YOUR ANSWER!

It is okay to give a small answer here, but you should NEVER just say YES or NO! that is a short answer and it is incorrect!

A: What do you like the most about your hometown?

B1: I like that it is small.

B2: My hometown is small, that's why I love being able to walk around the city and always find a familiar face. That is definitely what I like the most about it.
