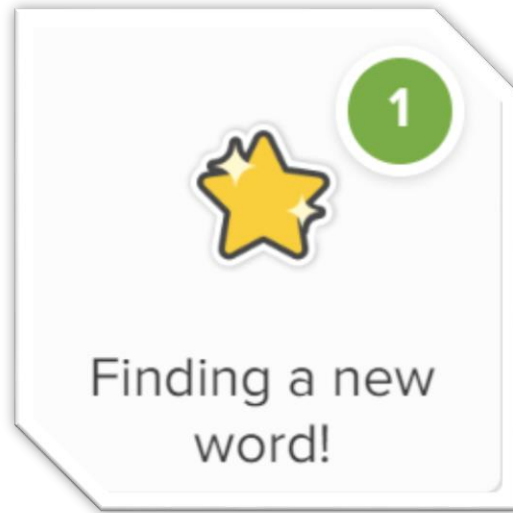
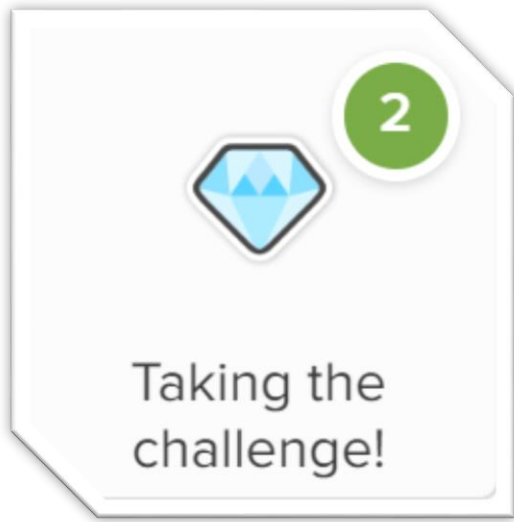

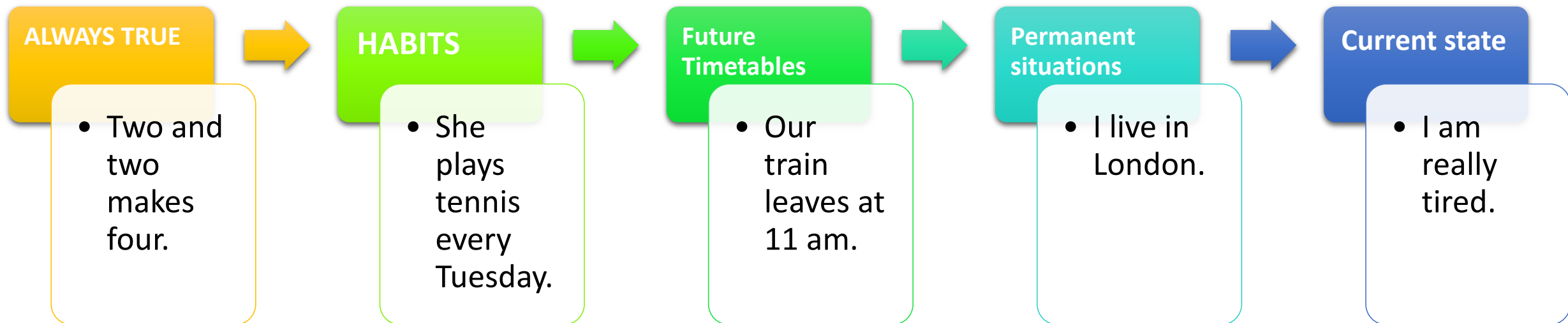

KEYWORDS: twice a month, often, sometimes, when, until, as soon as, after, before, this evening.

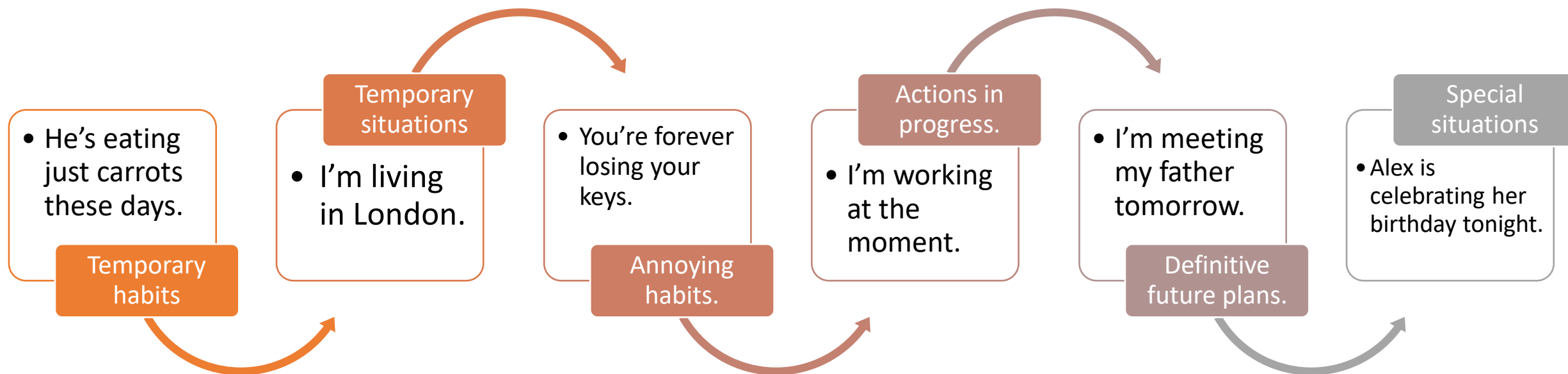


# Quick review

KEYWORDS: now, at the moment, for a few weeks, these days, tomorrow, later, tonight.
